ORDINANCE NO. 18-2006

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 95 OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF RIVERDALE AND PROVIDING FOR FEES FOR THE RENTAL OF THE BOROUGH SHOWMOBILE

WHEREAS, the Borough of Riverdale has acquired a showmobile; and

WHEREAS, the Borough will be offering the showmobile for rental to other organizations and desires to establish a fee for the rental of the municipal showmobile.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Riverdale, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 95 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Riverdale shall be amended by the inclusion of new Article V which shall be entitled "Showmobile Rental Fees", and shall read in its entirety as follows:

**Article V
Showmobile Rental Fees**

§ 95-12. Showmobile rental.

The Borough showmobile may be made available to rental to other qualified individuals and organizations pursuant to the rules and regulations established by the Borough Recreation Committee.

§ 95-13. Fees for showmobile rental.

The rental fees for the showmobile shall be as follows:

- A. The rental fee per day shall be \$500.00 for governmental and non-profit users and \$750.00 for all other users.

- B. In addition to the hourly fee, the Borough shall be paid a fee for the delivery, setup, and return by Borough of Riverdale employees. The fee shall be set annually by the Borough Council by Resolution and shall be based upon the Borough's costs to provide the required service.
- C. There shall also be an additional mileage charge, which shall be set by the Borough Council annually by Resolution.

Section 2. If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances, which are inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
