ORDINANCE NO. 19-2006

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 123 OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF RIVERDALE AND PROHIBITING OVERNIGHT PARKING AT MUNICIPAL PARKS AND FACILITIES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Riverdale, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 123 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Riverdale shall be amended by the inclusion of new Section 123-8 which shall be entitled "Overnight parking at municipal facilities", and shall read in its entirety as follows:

§ 123-8. Overnight parking at municipal facilities.

It shall be unlawful for any vehicle to be parked between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. at any municipal park or other municipal facility without obtaining specific written permission from the Borough of Riverdale.

Section 2. If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
